

Upcoming transition of the Vermont Supplemental Retirement Plans

Effective February 1, 2018, the following Vermont supplemental retirement plans are transferring their recordkeeping services to a new provider, Prudential Retirement®:

- State 457 Deferred Compensation Plan
- State Defined Contribution Plan
- Single Deposit Investment Account Plan

We are currently in the black out period, during this period your account records are being reconciled and moved to Prudential. At this time, you cannot make changes to your account, but you will be able to access your account with Prudential on February 12, 2018.
